



# Policy for Families Experiencing Financial Hardship

---

The Pre-school will help fund families with multiple births.

Families experiencing financial hardship may apply for help with fees from the Pre-school Learning Alliance "Help a Pre-school Child" Fund .

To receive help you must

- be in receipt of benefits or be on a low income
- have one or more children attending Pre-school
- have your child or children attending two or more sessions each week
- have your child or children attending regularly

If you wish to apply for assistance with funding, please approach a member of staff or Pre-school committee member. This process is entirely confidential.

The application will then be forwarded on to the Pre-school Learning Alliance "Help a Pre-school Child" Fund. There are strictly limited resources for help with fees. The P.L.A. assess the application forms and notify Braunston Pre-school of priority applicants who should receive financial help.

Your application will be dealt with as quickly as possible. A letter of support from your Doctor, Health Visitor or Social Worker is required. The Pre-school will notify you of the P.L.A. decision at the earliest opportunity.
